- 4g. Rhoda Virginia (Jinny) Simmons, b. Jan 22, 1870(F), m. Feb 18, 1892(F), George A. Booth, b. 1868, son of George B. & Susan Booth. Moved to Indianola, Iowa, before 1907.

- 3i. William Callaway Simmons, b. 1832(F), d. Jan 2, 1862, of bronchitis, m. Jan 1, 1860(F), Eliza Weddle, b. 1835, d. June 5, 1862, dau of Samuel & Mary Weddle; no children.
- William C., the youngest son, inherited the homeplace where he lived and died. He married Eliza Weddle in 1860. Two years later, 1862, he and his wife died within 6 months of each other. Presumably they were buried in Simmons Cem #1, the cemetery that he established.

- 3j. Permelia H. (Molly) Simmons, b. 1835(F), d. 1870-73, m. Jan 3, 1867(F) Gordon Cloyd Earles, wid, b. 1830(F), d. 1873, son of Frances Earles; 3 children.
- Molly, the youngest daughter, lived at the homeplace with her brother, William C., and her mother. She did not marry until after her mother's death. She came into possession of the entire homeplace; one-half left to her by her brother and she purchased the other half. She died about the age of 35 and her husband died a year or so later, leaving the three children orphans. They were raised by members of the family.
- 4a. William Henry S. Earles, twin, b. Dec 17, 1867(F). Went to New Canton, Illinois.
