Addie Lester Altizer had two nicknames, Addie and Sallie, most often called Addie. She was a devoted mother and housewife. She died of diabetes and a heart attack. Jacob Altizer was a respected and well-liked man. He was Supervisor of Montgomery County and had many influential friends. People in the community went to him for advice and counsel. Jacob and Addie lived on Little River on Chestnut Ridge in a big log house that was his father's home. In 1913 they built a large white frame house to replace the log house. The present owners have remodeled this house and it is now a show place.
